**Petition Information** ALL PETITIONS TO THE 2025 REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS MUST BE **SUBMITTED TO YOUR STATE CHAIRMAN AT STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.**

No petitions will be accepted if sent directly to the Regional Chairman. Petitions for all around only may only be submitted by the athlete's coach, and submitted petitions must meet protocol procedures and be fully documented for consideration. Petitions may only be submitted for athletes who are unable to compete at the qualifying competition due to injury, illness, or extenuating circumstance. - All questions regarding petitions should be directed to your State Chairman.

a. Coaches are responsible for submitting ALL required documentation for a petition to the State Chairperson before the competition begins. The State Chairman will then send all petitions to the Regional Chairman for evaluation and approval. Petitions will be very strictly evaluated. **Petitions without the required supporting documentations will not be considered.**

- A completed petition must include the following information:

- In the case of injury or illness, **a statement from a physician (M.D. or D.O.)** which clearly states the athlete is **medically cleared to participate**. Statements from non-physicians, i.e. athletic trainer, physical therapist, nurse practitioner, etc. will NOT be accepted;
- Scores from two (2) USAG Sanctioned Meets during the 25-26 season -
  - If Petitioning for JE, Technical Sequence scores with a 42.00 or higher all-around plus optional scores

b. Petitions for athletes injured during a competition must be turned in to the State Chairperson by the conclusion of the event where the injury occurs (unless an emergency situation dictates otherwise). Documentation must be received by the State Chairperson within 48 hours of the conclusion of the event and must include the same documentation stated above.

c. Petitions must be turned in at the State Championship and petition athletes must pay for Regional Championship at the State Championship.

d. Petitions that are not approved will receive a refund.

## **Regional Registration Procedure and Checklist**

**Parents and Guardians, please read this information carefully.**

- **Registration of athletes to the Regional Championships will be handled by the coach only.** Placing coaches in charge of this procedure simplifies the Registration process considerably.
  - **Each club will take care of the qualifiers entry fee at the state championship.**
  - Each club will determine how they receive entry fee and any applicable coaches fees with their qualified athletes.
- **Prior to the state championship, parents should verify and confirm with their coaches their intent for attending the regional championship** if their athlete qualifies. which of their athletes will attend the Regional Championships, if qualified.
  - Waiting until the day of the state championship, create confusion and slow down the determination of qualifiers for your state.

## **Schedule**

Some sessions on this schedule are different from their original tentative schedule as a result of official number of athletes entered into state championships.

Below is the travel schedule set for the Region 4 Championship. *The schedule listed below may change once all entries are received at the conclusion of the State Championships.* We have based these sessions on the numbers in the region that are allotted to attend the regional championships.

**Final session times** will be set after entries are received from all the state championships.

### **Thursday, March 26, 2026**

- Evening - Open Workout at venue (Level 8 - 10 JE ATHLETES ONLY)

### **Friday, March 27, 2026**

- Morning - Technical Sequence for all Level 8 - 10JE Athletes
- Afternoon - Level 7 JN (All Ages)
- Evening - Level 6 JE and Level 8 JN Only (All ages)

### **Saturday, March 28, 2026**

- Morning - Level 8 JE (12-13) and Level 9 JN (All Ages)
- Afternoon - Level 9 JE (14-15) and Level 10 SR (JE and JN 18+)
- Evening - Level 10 JR (JE and JN 16 - 17)

### **Sunday, March 29, 2026**

- Morning - Level 5 (D1 and D2 All Ages) and Level 6 D1
- Late Morning - Level 3 (D1 and D2 All Ages)
- Late Afternoon - Level 4 (D1 and D2 All Ages)

**AWARDS** - For all awards at Region 4 Championship, all levels and divisions will be divided into equal age groups based upon the total number of athletes in that session.

***The age determination date is December 31, 2026.***

## 2026 State Allotment Numbers

For Level 3 (D1/D2), Level 4 (D1/D2), Level 5 (D1/D2) and Level 6 (D1), and Level 7 (All Ages):

- Gymnasts qualify in rank order by combining all age groups in the All – Around at their respective State Championship. Otherwise, the Coach must submit a petition to the State Chairman.

For Level 6 (JE), 8 -10 all gymnasts that COMPETE AT THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS will qualify.

- Level 8, 9, 10 JE Athletes must achieve an all-around technical sequence score of 42.00 to compete as JE at Regional Championship.
- If this score is not achieved they will simply be registered as a JN.
